The Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) is a national program with a local, community-based emphasis. Its mission is to support community efforts to utilize local medical and health volunteers during emergencies and at other times of community need.

MRC volunteers work in coordination with existing local emergency response programs.



MRC volunteers supplement local public health response in the event of a major public health emergency such as:

- pandemic flu
- a bioterrorism event
- natural disaster.



A credentialing process is required for all MRC volunteers.

Students in health professions schools may participate in the MRC.

Enrollees and their families will be among the first group to receive medication or vaccine in order to provide care to others.
